Your personal health information and your medical records may be collected, used, and disclosed for the following reasons:

- For communication relevant information with other treating doctors, specialists, or allied health professionals.
- Billing purposes, including compliance with Medicare requirements
- For follow up reminders or recall notices by phone, email, or SMS.
- For National, State and Territory Registers (Eg: Immunisation Data)
- For State or Territory reminder systems (Eg: Cancer Registries or Cervical Screening Registry)
- Accounting, Medicare, and Health Insurance Procedures
- Quality assurance activities such as accreditation.
- For disease notification as required by law (Eg: Infectious disease)
- For use by all doctors and nurses in the practice when consulting with you.
- For legal related disclosures as required by the Court of Law
- For research purposes - de-identified. (Meaning you are not able to be identified from the information provided)

If you have any concerns or wish to restrict access to your personal health information, please discuss these concerns with your doctor or receptionist.
